Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your child has been identified to be eligible for Title I programs based on a number of factors: performance grades, a non-passing score in any of the NJSLA English Language Arts/Mathematics Assessments, teacher recommendations. These programs are designed to focus on supporting students in identified areas of improvement for achievement in the upcoming NJSLA assessments.

Your child has been selected to participate in a program involving additional instruction in Mathematics, Language Arts, or both, through placement in either Math Lab and/or English Lab for 2020-21 school year. Bergenfield High School receives Title I funds through the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). These funds allow us to provide additional services to students who may be at risk of failing. Students scheduled in a lab will receive this instruction throughout the year as needed. However, exit criteria includes, but is not limited to the following: a passing score on the NJSLA assessments in ELA/Math, report card grades and teacher recommendation and/or completion of the NJSLA portfolio. Other additional services available to your child that may be funded through Title I are as follows:

- BHS Writing Center
- Algebra I after school NJSLA prep
- Access to Library/Media Center After School Hours
- SAT preparation course
- English Language Learners Extended Day Program for math and language

We invite you to attend a meeting on Thursday, September 17th at 8:52pm after the Open House classroom visits in the auditorium to elaborate on these program offerings and discuss how we can best work together to ensure your child's academic success.
