




COLONEL FLOYD JAMES THOMPSON

July 8, 1933 - July 16, 2002

Floyd Jim Thompson lived at 113 Hickory Avenue and graduated from Bergenfield High School when the school was located at 130 S Washington Avenue in 1951. He was married to Alyce De Vries and they had 4 children, Laura, Ruth, Pamela and his son Floyd James Thompson, Jr.

On March 26th 1964 Captain Thompson was shot down near Quang Tri, South Vietnam and captured as a prisoner of war (POW) for 8 years and 355 days. He was severely tortured while a POW from March 26, 1964 to March 16, 1973. He received 29 US Awards and Decorations including the Prisoner of War Medal awarded by President Ronald Reagan at the White House in 1988. The book "Glory Denied: the saga of Jim Thompson" tells the complete story of his sacrifice for our country. Upon his release from captivity, he was promoted to lieutenant colonel and then to colonel.




