

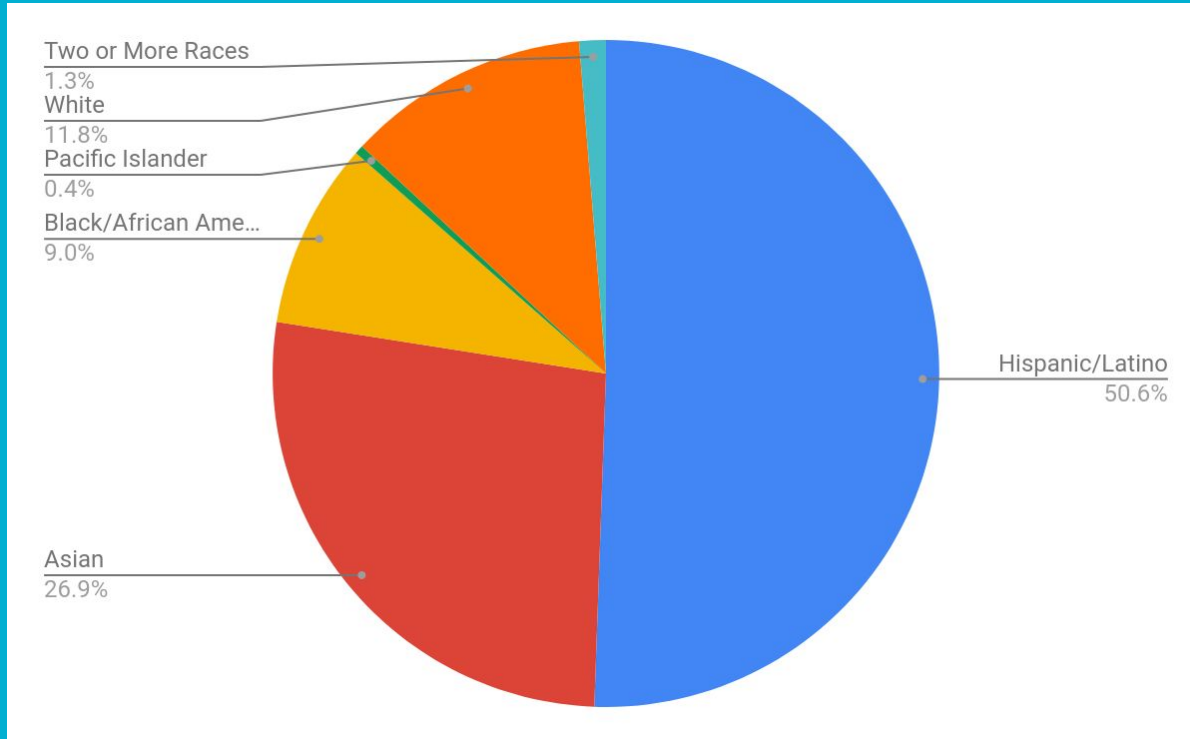
Practice Makes Possible

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- 100% participation in PSAT (grades 9, 10, 11) and SAT (11) during the school day



Buy-in

- Walkthrough for teachers
- Visiting classes to help students log in
- Coaching with Khan Academy
- Students have a feeling of ownership and responsibility for their scores and achievements

Technology

Successes

- Students can create their own practice schedules
- Students can see their scores, test questions, etc.

Challenges

- The Matching Tool vortex
- Remembering usernames/passwords
- Multiple accounts

Strategies for Success

- SAT Prep Academy - after school and evenings
 - Over 100 juniors enrolled
 - Using Khan Academy
- Persistence and patience
- Focus on improving scores to benefit the students
- Follow up with students regarding independent practice
- Teachers create classes and give assignments to students

Goals and Results

- Overall goal: help students help themselves to raise their scores
 - Students who set up their own practice schedules report that they feel more confident when taking the PSAT/SAT

- Goal: Teachers' daily lessons support the skills students need to raise their scores
 - Teachers use the SAT Question of the Day as a Do Now assignment
 - Teachers create classes in Khan Academy
 - Teachers drill down into their students' PSAT score reports to find trends of skill gaps and work with their students to close those gaps
